**A workshop with Dr. Gan Yu, March 5, 2019 5pm- 7pm**

The Islip Art Museum is proud to present the work of Chinese artist Yu Han Yu (b. 1964) in the exhibit ***The Majesty of Tibet: 60 Works of Ink Painting, Calligraphy, Photograph and Video, from January 15 through March 30 2019.***

On **March 5 2019** you are invited to meet the exhibits curator **Dr Gan Yu** . In a special program developed for educators and artists Dr. Yu will take us on a gallery tour and discuss the work of celebrated contemporary Chinese artist Yu Hanyu. After viewing the work Dr. Yu will also demonstrate and teach Chinese calligraphy techniques in the museum classroom.

Dr. Gan Yu is a teacher and artist who was born into a family of artists in Shanghai, China, and at the age of six started to practice Chinese calligraphy. He was fascinated by calligraphy's aesthetic structures and the rhythmical beauty of its strokes. This was the first and most direct influence on his artistic career.
