This project also addresses suicide prevention month and recovery month.

For this exhibit, veteran artists are invited to submit up to 3 original works of **any medium**.

Only professionally presented pieces, framed and ready to hang with screw eyes and wire, will be accepted— **NO** broken, damaged, or dirty frames, mats or glass. No work should exceed 42" outside frame dimensions. Sculptures must be light enough for one person to handle.

Artists may submit up to **3** works in .jpg format up to 1700pixels, 200 ppi through a Google Form.

DELIVERY & PICK-UP OF WORK

Accepted work is to be delivered to Islip Arts Council Gallery at the Westfield South Shore Mall on **October 4, 2022.**

Any work left with the Council beyond an artist's assigned pick-up date will be charged a warehousing fee of **\$5.00** per day.

Submitted work is juried for acceptance by the Curatorial Team of the Islip Arts Council, and all decisions are final. Submitting a work of art implies agreement on the part of the artist with all conditions set forth in this prospectus.

Works may be for sale. A 25% donation from sales will be accepted by the Islip Arts Council. The IAC will take reasonable care of submitted works but are not responsible for any loss or damage to said work.
