## CALL FOR ENTRIES

The Islip Arts Council Gallery is seeking artists to display a mini solo show in the wall space behind the gallery desks as the **Featured Artist of the Month**. Artists will have approximately 180" X 72" (15' X 6') of wall space to showcase their work.

All visual artists in New York are eligible to apply with all media to be considered. If artwork is accepted, a fee of \$50.00 must be made for the chosen month of exhibition. All payments can be made by visiting [www.isliparts.org](http://www.isliparts.org).

## APPLICATION PROCEDURE

**HOW TO SUBMIT**—All entries are to be sent via a **Google Form**. Forms can be retrieved at [www.isliparts.org](http://www.isliparts.org)

FORM SUBMISSION — Include:

1. Up to 10 images of work to be considered for display. Digital images must be in JPEG format (300 dpi).
2. Images must include title, size, media, and price. Please enter only completed work, no work-in-progress. Maximum size of work must not exceed 70 inches.
2. Contact information—Email and phone number
3. Artist's Statement (No more than one page)
4. OPTIONAL—CV or Resume of exhibition history and education.

If artwork requires special instructions and/or installation, please include in your submission.

Submissions that do not follow ALL the above guidelines will not be considered.

## ACCEPTED WORK

If artwork is accepted, a loan agreement form will be sent to the artist with the given month to display their work.

Accepted artists agree upon the given dates of delivery, display, reception, and retrieval of work.

Accepted artists agree to hand deliver and retrieve their works. Delivered works should be ready for hanging and/or installation.

An artist's reception date will be discussed and approved with and by artist.

## ELIGIBILITY AND TERMS

Works delivered in good condition are insured against loss or damage while in the gallery, from the date of delivery through the last date of retrieval. Artists agree to the following:

- IAC inspects all work for damage prior to installation. IAC is not responsible for any loss or damage of work in transit or work left behind past pick-up date.
- Delivered works should be ready for hanging and/or installation. Inappropriately presented work will not be accepted.
- Accepted artists agree to give permission to the Islip Arts Council to use images of their work as promotional material.
- Artists who sell works while displayed at IAC Gallery agree to a 25% commission of these sales to the Islip Arts Council.

### *Liability*

*Work will be insured for the exhibition period only. The Islip Arts Council staff will handle your submission with care but is not responsible for damage to fragile or poorly constructed items. Artists should keep in mind that their work may be moved frequently during the selection process.*
